Please follow these directions to park in the **E1 Lot**, which is located on the north side of Husky Stadium on the east side of Montlake Boulevard NE. Parking Services will have staff available at the entrances of E-1 from 6:30 am-9 am both day to expedite parking. *Parking will be \$6 per day payable by cash only*. Please note that this lot does not have in/out privileges. If you arrive after 9 am there is a self-serve payment kiosk at the gate entrance to the lot, which requires cash or coins paid on entry. There is a machine to make change however it can malfunction. Please try to have exact change.

The lot is ¼ mile away from the HUB (Husky Union Building). Allow 15 minutes to walk to the course using the pedestrian overpass at the E-1 lot. The overpass walkway/stair climb will lead pedestrians up to the main campus. Follow the signs from the pedestrian overpass. Turn left on Stevens Way and walk to the HUB building located a short distance on your right hand side. Please refer to the attached map. *If you need special accommodations for parking, please check with one of the parking gatehouses on campus when you arrive.*

Driving Directions to E1 Parking lot:

From Interstate 5 take State Route 520 (exit 168B); Exit at Montlake Boulevard; make a left turn at the stoplight and continue north on Montlake past Husky Stadium to lot E-1 on the right.

From westbound State Route 520, take the Montlake boulevard exit. Drive north on Montlake past Husky Stadium to lot E-1 on the right.

<u>Please enter by driving past the E-1 lot and turning right on NE 44th/Walla-Walla Road, entering the lot on the east side.</u>
