

Accrediting bodies require a documented process for reviewing and mitigating potential Conflicts of Interest (COI) and determining their relevancy.

Peer Reviewers are assigned to each activity by a designated activity coordinator. Mitigation by a Peer reviewer is completed through the CloudCME Attendee Portal (AP) \rightarrow Faculty.

- 1. Please do not use Internet Explorer or Edge. Our system works best with Chrome and Firefox.
- 2. Go to uwcme.org
- 3. Sign-In to the portal using your email as your login and enter your password
- 4. Select the "Faculty" tab from the main menu
- 5. You should now see My Tasks:



6. Scroll to the bottom of the page, you will have a variety of Task Tabs, depending on your role in the program. You may have assigned tasks under each tab for Global, Activity, Peer Reviewer, and Upcoming Presentations. Select the Peer Reviewer Tasks tab:
