WHO SHOULD ATTEND

This course is intended for radiologists (residents, fellows and attendings) and imaging technologists. Other practitioners in Emergency Medicine may also find the imaging approach and interpretation to be useful – such as PAs, NPs and MDs working in emergency departments.
