COURSE DESCRIPTION

This four-day program will incorporate data supporting guideline-based recommendations and recent advances regarding therapeutic options in patients with malignant solid tumor and hematologic disorders. At the end of the course, physicians will leave with a deeper understanding of the pathogenesis, diagnostic evaluation and therapeutic modalities available for common solid tumor malignancies, hematologic malignancies and the bleeding/thrombotic patient.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

Upon completion of this course, participants will be able to:

- Describe the pathogenesis, diagnostic evaluation and therapeutic modalities available for common malignant hematological diseases
- Describe the pathogenesis, diagnostic evaluation and therapeutic modalities available for common solid tumor malignancies
- Integrate new therapeutic and diagnostic approaches into clinical practice as appropriate
- Manage and evaluate the bleeding and clotting patient

The target audience for this activity will be physicians who are preparing for the Medical Oncology certification or re-certification examinations and physicians and allied health professionals who desire an update in current standards of care for patients with cancer nationwide.
