WHO SHOULD ATTEND

The primary audience will be radiologists (residents, fellows, and practicing radiologists) and imaging technologists. Other practitioners in Emergency Medicine may also find the imaging approach and interpretation useful – such as PAs, NPs, and MDs working in emergency departments.

COURSE DESCRIPTION

This course will provide an update and review on the imaging appearance of trauma and stroke, with a special focus on the key aspects of diagnosis and management, from the perspective of a regional network of care. Content will include indications for a higher level of care, radiology considerations for evacuation and transport, quality improvement, lessons learned, and local responsibilities in regional disaster response. Content will be presented by world renowned experts from the University of Washington and from trauma centers across the United States and Canada including the perspectives of surgery, emergency medicine, neurology, regional emergency transport, trauma network managers, and policy-makers.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

Upon completion of this activity, attendees should be able to:

- Determine appropriate imaging protocols.
- Recognize common and uncommon conditions encountered in emergency radiology.
- Provide appropriate recommendations for incidental findings.
