

CME Pricing Tier – Non-Major Courses

Application & Certificate Fees for CME Category 1 Credit

External Activities (live activities)

\$650	8 hours or less
\$800	8.25 – 16 hours
\$950	16.25 – 64 hours
\$1,200	64.25 hours or more

Jointly-Provided Activities (live activities produced with a non-UW entity)

\$2,500	8 hours or less
\$4,000	8.25 – 16 hours
\$4,100+	16.25 hours or more

+ each hour above 16.0 incurs an additional \$100 fee per hour

Enduring Materials (2-year accreditation term)

\$2,500	departmental enduring material (designed and produced by the department)

Industry Support

All commercial support funding (*educational grants from ineligible companies*) received for CME-accredited activities must be deposited through the CME Office and then transferred to a UW cost center. A 10% overhead fee is retained.

Application Fees

UW CME requires the application fee payment upon review. Upon submission of the CME application, the requester agrees to pay the application fee in full. Application fees are non-refundable. Activities offered by a UW School of Medicine department will not incur application fees unless otherwise noted.

Rush Fees

Applications submitted less than 90 days before the requested start date of the activity may incur rush fees for expedited review. The fees noted below are added to the base application fee.

\$150	31-90 days or less before activity start date
\$300	30 days or less before activity start date

Certificate Fees

A **\$25-\$65 per registrant per activity certificate fee** is charged by the CME Office for all external and jointly sponsored CME-accredited activities. Certificate fees are based on the number of hours claimed. UW School of Medicine faculty certificate fee cost is \$0.
