
Accessing the Online Content

To access to the content, click the hyperlink on the main page for the education module you want to purchase. Register for the education module, then continue with these instructions.

1. Navigate to “MyCME” at the top and center of your screen.
2. Select “Tests”.
 - a. New and/or incomplete tests will display automatically on this page.
 - b. Read the activity information for the module prior to starting your pre-test.
 - c. You must complete the pre-test to enable the video.
 - d. You must complete the pre-test prior to completing the post-test.
 - e. A PDF of the presentation available for download can be found above the pre-test button.
