- Summarize appropriate inpatient management strategies for patients with heart failure and chronic kidney disease.
- Identify and manage hematologic and oncologic emergencies.
- Recognize appropriate inpatient management techniques of patients with sepsis.
- Identify and manage rheumatologic emergencies.
- Describe the principles of addiction medicine and manage hospitalized patients with substance use disorder.
