This conference is the 21st annual update for healthcare providers who provide care to women+ on relevant topics. The topics are selected based on suggestions from previous course attendees, areas with substantial change, and controversial subjects where medical opinions may differ. The purpose is to provide a clinical update for providers who care for these patients in an outpatient setting. The format of the program includes lectures with the opportunity for question-and-answer at the end of the lecture.
