## **DIRECTIONS & MAPS**

All major and domestic airlines serve Seattle-Tacoma International Airport. Depending on traffic and weather, transfer time from the airport to the Hotel is 20 to 30 minutes. All major car rental companies operate at the airport, and taxi and limousine services are available.

### **SERVICES PROVIDED BY THE HOTEL**

The Hotel offers a complimentary car service on a first-come, first-served basis for locations in the immediate downtown area. Service is not available to all cruise ship terminals or to stadiums during sports events. Valet parking is also available; fees apply.

### **DIRECTIONS FROM SEA-TAC AIRPORT**

- Upon exiting the airport, take State Route 518 to Interstate 5 North
- Stay on Interstate 5 for approximately 13 miles (21 kilometres)
- Exit at Seneca Street and stay in the left hand lane to continue straight onto Seneca Street
- Continue on Seneca Street to 1st Avenue, then make a right onto 1st Avenue
- Continue for two blocks to Union Street
- Turn left onto Union Street to pull into the Four Seasons Hotel drive
- The Hotel will be on your left on the corner of 1st Avenue and Union Street.

**Approximate Drive Time:** 20-40 minutes (depending on traffic and construction)

**Distance in miles:** 24 kilometers or 15 miles from Downtown Seattle

### **PARKING**

Valet parking only is available at the hotel, however, there is another parking lot nearby with self parking:

1. **Russell Investments Center** – garage entrance is located on Union Street between 1st and 2<sup>nd</sup> (adjacent to the Seattle Arts Museum building). <http://www.rpnw.com/lot/seattle/30-529>

### **PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION**

Take Metro (Seattle's great public bus system) or Sound Transit Light Rail. Many Metro bus routes will drop you off near the hotel on 3<sup>rd</sup> and Union. And the Westlake Sound Transit Link Light Rail station is located only 0.3 miles away from the hotel.
