Husky Union Building (HUB) – Lyceum (1st Floor)
Registration and Sign-in in Pre-Function Space of the Lyceum on the 1st Floor

The **Husky Union Building (HUB)** is located on Stevens Way near the center of the UW campus and in between Hall Health and Suzzallo Library. Please see the map on the last page of this document.

DRIVING DIRECTIONS

Driving Directions from the NORTH via I-5 southbound

- From I-5 southbound, take the NE 45th Street exit (#169).
- Turn left onto NE 45th Street.
- Continue east about one quarter mile to 17th Avenue NE and turn right onto Memorial Way.
- Turn left at the first intersection onto Steven’s Way.
- Once at the intersection (stop sign) of Steven’s Way and Pend Orielle Rd turn left again.
- Padelford Parking garage will be on your right after the next stop sign.

Driving Directions from the SOUTH via I-5 northbound

- From I-5 northbound, take the NE 45th Street exit (#169).
- Turn right onto NE 45th Street.
- Continue east about one quarter mile to 17th Avenue NE and turn right onto Memorial Way.
- Turn left at the first intersection onto Steven’s Way.
- Once at the intersection (stop sign) of Steven’s Way and Pend Orielle Rd turn left again.
- Padelford Parking garage will be on your right after the next stop sign.

Driving Directions from the EAST via State Route 520

- Coming from the east use State Route 520.
- Take the Montlake Boulevard exit.
- Cross the drawbridge and continue north on Montlake Blvd.
- Use the left lane to turn slightly left onto 25th Ave NE.
- Turn left at the light onto Pend Oreille Rd.
- Turn left at the stop sign for access to the Padelford Parking garage.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR PARKING

Parking is available on a first come first served basis in the Padelford Garage **Lots N-20 or N-21**. There is a **self-service pay station** in each lot where you will need to pay the appropriate fee each day (\$15 for weekday parking). Park in a spot in either lot N-20 or N-21 and **note your vehicle license number** before proceeding to a nearby machine to pay. Because your license number is stored in the machine, there is no need to return to your car or display a permit on your vehicle. These machines accept Visa or MasterCard. Payments are not refundable. **Please arrive early** as the pay station can get very busy due to the many off campus visitors during conference days.

Once you have parked take the escalators up to Steven’s Way. Please refer to the map on the last page of this document to review the location of the HUB.

*If lots N-20 and N-21 in the Padelford Garage are full, **overflow parking is available in lot E-18**. Exit left out of the Padelford Garage and turn right onto Pend Orielle Rd. Turn right at the light on Montlake Blvd. and left after the second pedestrian overpass to enter the parking area. See map for exact location and walking directions.*

Alternative parking is also available in the E-1 Parking Lot

E-1 is north of Husky Stadium and the IMA sports facility

Parking Near Campus

From Interstate 5 take State Route 520 (exit 168B); Exit at Montlake Boulevard; make a left turn at the stoplight and continue north on Montlake past Husky Stadium to lot E-1 on the right.

From westbound State Route 520, take the Montlake boulevard exit. Drive north on Montlake past Husky Stadium to lot E-1 on the right.

Please enter by driving past the E-1 lot from Montlake and turning right on NE 44th/Walla-Walla Road. This lot ***only accepts credit card payment*** (Visa or Mastercard). The daily rate for parking is \$6.00 (there are no in and out privileges). Your credit card must be swiped to enter the gates. When leaving, use the same credit card to exit and pay for the parking. The lot is ¼ mile away from the HUB. Allow 15 minutes to walk using the pedestrian overpass at the E-1 lot. The overpass walkway will lead pedestrians up several flights of stairs to the main campus in between Padelford and Hall Health. Turn left on Stevens Way and walk to the HUB building located a short distance on your right hand side. Please refer to map on back.

Other Transportation Options

The University of Washington encourages you to join our efforts to improve traffic conditions and to protect the environment. There are over 50 bus routes from all over King and Snohomish counties serving the University District: about 30 buses come right to campus. Getting here by bus is easy and less expensive.
