

Mar 12-13, 2021 Updates in Endocrinology and Diabetes for Primary Care

This is a comprehensive two-day course on principles of endocrinology and diabetes geared toward primary care providers. There have been vast changes in the fields of endocrinology and diabetes over the past decade. Primary care providers often are faced with diagnosing many conditions such as thyroid disorders, calcium disorders, and osteoporosis. Diabetes rates continue to rise with limited resources. Apr 23, 2021 20th Annual Clinical Cardiology Pearls for Primary Care

This is tailored for a primary care audience and is intended to provide practical, up-to-date information on commonly encountered cardiovascular diseases. World-class faculty from the University of Washington School of Medicine will teach participants using case-based lectures and an audience response system to encourage online interactive dialogue. Recent guidelines for hypertension, cholesterol management, and diabetes will be reviewed. *(Live Webinar)*

Apr 26-30, 2021 Physical Medicine & Rehabilitation Board Review

This course is designed as a comprehensive review for physicians preparing for ABPM&R Part 1 or 2 Board Certification or re-certification examinations. The curriculum is divided into modules chaired by expert faculty, and uses live and recorded content with a heavy focus on cases. Oral board practice exam options are available. *(Live Webinar)*

Jun 8-10, 2021 Updates in Hospital Medicine

This course offered by the University of Washington is directed toward hospital medicine clinicians. The purpose of the course is to update the skills of inpatient providers with a focus on common problems in clinical care, this year highlighting COVID. The format consists of presentations followed by Q&A where participants will be able to ask real-time questions. *(Live Webinar)*

Jun 30, 2021 18th Update: Travel Medicine in the Era of COVID

This conference will provide an overview of travel medicine and global health and is targeted toward physicians and other health professionals with an interest in travel medicine and global health. Morning sessions will focus on traditional travel medicine topics, with the afternoon sessions addressing travel in the era of COVID-19. *(Live Webinar)*
