21st Annual Cardiology Pearls for Primary Care April 29, 2022

This course is tailored for a primary care audience and is intended to provide practical, up-to-date information on commonly encountered cardiovascular diseases. July 21-22, 2022 Updates in Hospital Medicine

2nd North American Workshop on Vascular Ultrasound **August 19-21, 2022** 2nd North American Workshop on Vascular Ultrasound This course is designed to provide basic training for the rheumatologist in performing vascular

ultrasound for the diagnosis of large vessel vasculitis. Hands-on training will be a significant component of this activity, partnered with expert faculty in the field, who will discuss and demonstrate how to identify the basic vascular pathological findings. Intermediate to advanced skill in the performance of ultrasound is strongly recommended as a prerequisite to this course. (In Person at the Graduate Hotel.)

August 26-27, 2022 Men's Health Update

An internationally acclaimed faculty has been assembled to provide this update, with presentations on topics such as prostate screening and treatment, testosterone deficiency and the controversy of testosterone replacement, male urinary dysfunction, kidney and bladder pathology, sexual dysfunction, male infertility and the changing influence of marijuana, and genital pain syndromes. During the plenary sessions, the registrants will have the opportunity to participate in case discussions and question/answer sessions. (Online via Live Webinar.)
